Caring for Colorado and the Colorado Health Foundation Partner to Expand Access to Oral Health Care

Denver, CO – Caring for Colorado Foundation, together with its funding partner, the Colorado Health Foundation, are happy to announce grant awards for the [SMILES Dental Project](#). The following organizations will each receive three years of funding in the amount of \$500,000 to pilot test a new dental care delivery model in Colorado, including:

- Dental Aid, Inc. serving Boulder County
- Salud Family Health, serving Morgan and Logan counties
- Tri-County Health Network, serving San Miguel, Montrose, Ouray, Dolores and Delta counties
- Summit Community Care Clinic, serving Lake, Park and Summit counties
- Mountain Family Health Center, serving Garfield and Eagle counties.

SMILES Dental Project -- Spanning Miles In Linking Everyone to Services -- is a community-based initiative designed to expand access to oral health care for Colorado's most vulnerable populations. The project relies on a hub-and-spoke model to integrate Registered Dental Hygienists (RDHs) into community settings such as community centers, schools, Head Start programs, nursing homes and assisted living facilities where they provide routine, preventive dental services. The RDHs communicate with a "hub" dentist via telehealth technology for patient assessments, treatment planning and to facilitate treatment for patients identified with more complex dental health needs.

As many as half of all Coloradans – most of whom live in low-income or rural communities with dental workforce shortages – don't receive routine, preventive oral health care and are therefore unable to conveniently access dental care in the traditional manner. The SMILES Dental Project is designed to address barriers to care and increase dental care utilization among those most in need.
